REPORT FROM THE MAYOR

- ◆ On Thursday, November 2, from 9:30 to 10:30, we will again have the Board of Health here for Flu Vaccine Shots. Charge for the shots will be \$25 unless you are a member of Medicare Part B. Please bring your card with you.
- ◆ When you are renewing or applying for license plates, be sure to state Glenwillow as your taxing district even though you may use Solon as a mailing address. Otherwise, the license tax monies you pay, along with other gas tax distributions from the state will go to Solon rather than Glenwillow.
- ◆ Collection of garbage or refuse to be picked up by the Village for disposal shall be placed at the street or anywhere on the front lawn or in the front driveway for pick-up after 5:00 PM on the day before pickup. Please do not leave the containers out after nightfall on the day of the pick up. If your trash was put out at the requested time and did not get picked up, please call BFI at 216-441-6300 and ask for pick up of residential trash.
- ◆ Upon any street or highway outside a business or residence district, no person shall stop, park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, upon the paved or main traveled part of the street or highway if it is practicable to stop, park or so leave such vehicle off the paved or main traveled part of such street or highway. In every event, a clear and unobstructed portion of the street or highway opposite such standing vehicle shall be left for the free passage of other vehicles, and a clear view of such stopped vehicle shall be available from a distance of 200 feet in each direction upon such street or highway.
- ◆ Open burning—As everyone starts their yard clean-up, I want to remind our residents that the Codified Ordinance states no open burning is permitted in the Village of Glenwillow.
- ◆ There is an emergency ordinance amending the codified ordinance regulations of dangerous and vicious dogs. If the Animal Warden or designee determines that a dangerous or vicious dog is being kept within the Village, the Animal Warden or designee shall then determine the individual, firm or corporation who, from the records in the Auditor's Office of Cuyahoga County, appears to be the owner of the dog, or if such information is not available., the titled owner of the property upon which the dog is kept, and shall, within five days, cause a written notice to be served on such owner. Notice shall be served by certified mail with a return receipt requested or by personal service. If service of such written notice is unable to be perfected, then the Animal Warden shall cause a copy of the aforesaid notice to be served by ordinary mail which shall be deemed complete upon mailing, and also left with the individual, if any, in possession of the premises on which the dog is kept, or if there is no individual in possession of the premises, he or she shall cause a copy of the notice to be posted on the premises.
- ◆ Daylight savings time ends on Sunday, October 29th. Please do not forget to set your clocks **back** on Sunday, October 29th.


