REQUEST FOR DESIGN APPROVAL TO PERMIT THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ACCESSORY BUILDING ON PERMANENT PARCEL # 991-05-004:

Building Official Bob Rodic reported; Joseph Kulis, the owner of the property known as PP# 991-05-004 is requesting design approval to permit the construction of an accessory building upon his property. The 20.78-acre parcel is an agricultural use and is located in the Country Home District. The application includes the nature of request, a site plan, a location plan, an aerial view, elevational views, and a photo of the existing detached garage. The nature of request narrative does indicate that the accessory building will match the siding and roof colors of the main structure and attached garage. However, the accessory structure will have vertical metal siding in place of horizontal vinyl siding. The plan complies with the zoning code.

Law Director Mark Marong commented; at the Planning Commission this evening, discussion ensued about where the building was going to go and on what lot. The applicant, Mr. Kulis, is withdrawing his variance requests and will resubmit them. The Board can do one of two things; wait until the process moves forward and see exactly what the structure will look like and where it will be or if the Board feels there is enough information, the request can be passed subject to Planning Commissions approvals.

Joe Kulis commented; everything in his current application will stay the same. He is not going to make any changes to the building. The colors and materials of the structure will all stay the same. The only change he is making is consolidating the lots.

Motion by Tim Haupert second by Roberto Pinedo for design approval to permit the construction of an accessory building subject to matching the roof and siding color to the house and subject to Planning Commissions site plan approval and any required variances needed for the project.
