## 2024 GLENWILLOW ROAD CLOSURE

The Village's annual concrete maintenance program for 2024 will include the installation of pedestrian cross walks on Austin Powder at three different locations – north of North Village Lane, north of South Village Lane and south of the southern entrance to the Donald Norman Payne parking lot. As part of this work the contractor will need to perform repairs that will require the closure of Austin Powder for two different times.

The first closure will be closing access to Austin Powder from Pettibone Road. This closure will begin September 3<sup>rd</sup> at 5 am and it will last up to seven (7) days. All traffic to access North and South Village Lane and Donald Norman Payne parking lot will be routed to Cochran Road to enter and exit the subdivision.

The second closure will begin on September 9<sup>th</sup> at 5 am and it will last up to seven (7) days. All traffic on the second closure will require all traffic to access the Donald Norman Payne parking lot, North and South Village Lanes to come from Pettibone Road. Some residents and businesses on Austin Powder will need to drive through North and South Village Lanes to access Pettibone Road. During the second closure Austin Powder will be open to the Odd Fellow's Camp.

The Village's contractor will have a detour posted that will use Pettibone Road and Cochran Road to route traffic around the construction zone. Please use caution while driving through this area and pay close attention to pedestrians and other vehicles.
